Digitizing halftone color prints by flatbed scanner: the challenges

To understand why the color plates provided in the following pages may look suboptimal, to say the least!, one should understand the technical challenges inherent to the digitalization of halftone color prints, especially from small originals with quite coarse (“newspaper”) halftone screen resolution.

In November 2021, after a long search I was able to acquire a copy of the rare and well-known 1986 book by Petuch and Sargent. As Ed Petuch himself said on the Facebook group “Olivoidea”, «*The publisher (CERF) told us that the book was going to be of a larger size (8 1/2 by 11 inches), sort of an expanded version of Ziegler and Porreca's older book. Well, this is what he gave us; a small book with tiny photos! We were not happy, but what can you do?».*

In fact, the small size of the pictures makes difficult to take full advantage of the book. To improve the usability of the color plates, I requested and obtained Ed's permission to process them via scanner and image editing software, as needed to obtain the clearest digital copy possible.

After test scans used to determine the resolution of the halftone screen (a parameter controlling the image scanning process) and the dot size of the low-pass Gaussian filter used to descreen the resulting images in the post-processing phase, the 39 color plates were scanned separately.

Judging from the reflections of the lights of the photographic stand, each plate looks like a composition of cutouts from separate photographs. Exposure times seem to vary widely even among the images of a single plate, as required by the relative lightness or darkness of each shell pictured. Besides dealing with the impossibility to find exposure adjustment levels fit for the entirety of each plate, I also had to address the white balance issue, on two fronts: a) making reasonable assumptions about the light temperature during the photographic process, and b) mitigating the color shift from deterioration spurred by acidification, oxidation, and other factors.

To help me in that respect, Ed kindly identified *O. incrassata* color form *nivea* as one of the whitest shells pictured. A very small digital cutout from that shell was used as white balance sample, in the following steps: the 3px by 3pix cutout was saved in color-indexed 256 color mode, magnified on screen and captured as an around 100px by 100px square; after full-surface descreening by gaussian blur, that reference square was digitally superimposed on each plate; then, the “remove color cast” function was applied by sampling the reference square, subsequently removed from all the plates.

This process ensured that all the plates were consistently white-balanced, following the assumption that every picture in every plate was photographed under the same conditions.

The color cast removal generally resulted in colder images, with whites turning to very light sky blue: one may draw the conclusion that all the pictures were taken under warm light, and/or that the printing process increased the warm (reddish) hues, now almost completely removed at the price of slightly blue halos around the printed characters of the plates. Fortunately, Ed confirmed that «...yes, all the photos had a pinkish tone added to them that wasn't there on the original photos».

Exposure was separately corrected in brightness and contrast for lights and shadows.

Note: In the case of the following plates: 9, 10, 24, 28 the alignment of the printing screens was very poor: as a consequence, the pictures look blurred to the unaided eye, and even more blurred after processing.

Note: Scanned plates are separately available for anybody, who deems the color rendering too cold, to try different white balancing strategies – contact me or Edward Petuch






Plate 2. *Acutoliva* species.
















